### Conditions of Entry

1. All registered, club and competitive swimmers are eligible to enter.
2. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under IPC Swimming Rules.
3. Age as at **25 May 2024**  
**This is a Not Faster Than Meet**, please refer to the table of qualifying times below. Swimmers must not have achieved a faster time than the maximum entry time shown for each event. There are Not Faster Than times for all ages and events.  
**The 200 Butterfly is restricted to swimmers aged 12 years and older.**
4. Entry fees are: Individual Entry – **\$8.00**
5. **Online entries only** – Entries close on **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May at midnight**.  
There will be no refunds on entry fees except as per the scratching rules.
6. **QEII Swim Club** reserves the right to restrict entries to ensure the timeline and the Health and Safety requirements of the venue are adhered to.
7. Submission of entries constitutes acceptance of these Meet Rules and Conditions.
8. Late entries will be at the Technical Advisor and/or Referees discretion based on lane space availability. A late entry fee of \$10.00 per event will be payable and swimmers will not be eligible for prizes or points. These will be swum as exhibition swims only.
9. Please check names, entries and events are correct on receipt of confirmation. Corrections will only be made to entries where errors have occurred. Final psych sheets will be posted on the SCWC website and sent out on the Wednesday prior to the meet.

## **MEET RULES**

### **General**

1. The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand's 'SNZ Regulations & By Laws, World Aquatics Rules except where local meet rules and conditions apply. This includes the SCWC Technical Suit Policy for all competitors 12 years of age and under.
2. **This is a Not Faster Than, SNZ Designated National Qualifying Meet.**
3. Events will be swum as timed finals and swum mixed gender – seeded slowest to fastest.
4. Reseeding may be done at the discretion of the Technical Advisor and/or Referee.
5. Electronic Timing will be used at this meet with one timekeeper per lane with the use of buttons.
6. Over the top starts will apply for individual events.
7. Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ Regulation 4, accompanied with the \$100.00 fee.
8. Entry to the pool for backstroke events shall be feet first. No swim back permitted.
9. Please exit the pool at the side. **Do not swim over the lane ropes.**

### **Scratching/Withdrawals**

1. All event scratching received before midnight 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2024 will be exempt from Entry Fees
2. Scratching's for the first session must be submitted by 12pm 24<sup>th</sup> May 2024 to qeiiiswimclub@gmail.com
3. Scratching for subsequent sessions must be submitted no later than 15 minutes after the completion of the session before.
4. Swimmers are deemed to have withdrawn if they do not report to the Clerk of Course (Marshall) at the appropriate time prior to their event and the withdrawal fee will apply.
5. A \$20.00 fine will apply without excuse to all late or non-scratching from events.
6. Refunds may be considered, providing a medical certificate is provided.

### **Warm Up/Warm Down**

7. As per Swimming Canterbury West Coast warm-up procedure guidelines.
8. Warm-up is the responsibility of the clubs, coaches and swimmers involved. **Officials are not** responsible for managing or controlling the warm-up procedures.
9. 3 lanes of the Recreation Pool are available for warm down from 10.30am – 1.30pm and 4.45pm-8pm on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2024.

### **Marshalling**

1. Marshalling will be outside the sports pool.
2. All swimmers must marshal for their events.
3. Swimmers should be in the marshalling area four (4) races prior to their event for distances of 200m and under and at least two (2) races prior for 400m and above races.

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded to swimmers who better their entry

### **Cameras and Photography**

SCWC and/or the host Club may take photos and videos during the meet: all spectators and athletes agree to allow photos, video and audio recording to be taken by an SCWC approved and/or accredited person to be used for any legitimate purposes by SCWC and/or the meet organisers. Any concerns should be directed to the meet organisers. Spectators agree upon entry that photographic, video or audio recording equipment is prohibited for any purpose, with the exclusion of personal cell phones. The meet organisers will, at their sole discretion, determine whether or not an item which could be used for the purposes of taking photos, video or audio recordings is permitted for use during the meet. Photos remain copyright of the approved/accredited person.

## Special Events –

### Relay

- 1 In the event that the timeline allows, at the end of the session one there will be a mixed 8 x 50m Medley relay. Swum in the following order 1 Backstroke, 2 Breaststroke, 2 Butterfly and 3 Freestyle. Clubs will be notified once entries have closed.
- 2 Relay team names, in order of swim, must be submitted to the Control Desk by the end of warm up. Each team will comprise of 4 male and 4 female swimmers, one of each from the following: 11 & under, 12-13, 14-15, and 16 & over, all swimmers must have competed in at least one event at this meet.
- 3 If your club is unable to furnish a relay team, it may combine with another club, so long as that club is unable to furnish a relay team.
- 4 There will be a maximum of eight (8) teams.
- 5 Prize money: \$120.00 prize money to be divided evenly between team. This will be given to the Team Manager or coach for distribution.

### IM Skins Event – Event 4: 200IM is the qualifying event.

Age Groups (Boys and Girls): 14 & under and 15 & over - With a random draw, for the event order

Top 8 boys and top 8 girls will race for top 6

Top 6 boys and top 6 girls will race for top 4

Top 4 boys and top 4 girls will race for top 2

Final will be between final two swimmers (boys and girls, each age group)

The skins will not be timed and finish places will be judged.

Where a race is too close to call, in the opinion of the judges, the race will be re-swum.

The judge's decision is final.

**Skins Prize: \$50.00 cash winner takes all (male, female, each age group)**

**Officials Convenor to advise all those officiating at the meet that they are required to report to the referee at the start of warm-up please. Referees, IOTS & the Chief Timekeeper need to report in plenty of time. Earlier than the start of warm-up is preferable.**

**As per the Swimming New Zealand Regulations there is a minimum number and standard of officials required for a meet to be approved as a Designated meet and for the times swum to be accepted for national event qualification. The 'Minimum Officials for Designated Meets' sheet must be completed for each session, signed by the Referee and sent to the region. The region must, within seven (7) days of the completion of the meet forward the meet results and the officials sheet/s to SNZ.**
