Events Committee notes from meeting held on Friday 18th August

at Joe's Garage, Upper Riccarton

<u>South Islands feedback</u> – Fiona had a few comments re South Islands Short Course. It was a good meet but she requested a few changes for next year:

- Could the points only go down to the amount of swimmers in the finals? ie. if it's a 10 lane pool the points go to 10th place and in an 8 lane pool to 8th place. Having points to 16th place meant they had to be entered manually which was quite challenging especially for the Sunday afternoon session.
- There was no scratching rule for the finals on the flyer so swimmers could scratch up to 30 minutes before the finals sessions started!!



• The Regional Trophy does not say anything about the number of Clubs needed, eg. if there's only one club entered from a region with a couple of swimmers it does skew the figures.

<u>Covid</u> – as all restrictions due to Covid have now been removed we can remove the paragraphs from our flyers.

Memorial Meet – the flyer and MM file are done and will be sent to Debbie shortly.

<u>Coaches Invitational/SCWC Regional meet</u> – this meet will go ahead at the end of January 2024 but will be run by SCWC, ie. Debbie and the Events Committee. Fiona will work on the flyer and MM file.

<u>NZ Short Course</u> – the date has been announced as 20-24 August 2024 so we will need to move the Timaru meet. One idea was to move it to the same weekend as NZ Secondary Schools as it doesn't cater to the same swimmers but we need to discuss with Timaru Swim Club.

<u>Relays at Club meets</u> – We are hoping that 4 x 100m events will be picked up by Clubs rather than asking them to do them. Wharenui will be having a 4 x 200m freestyle, Open age group only. Nicola said Jasi may do something as did Alex re Waitaha. So this is still a work in progress.

<u>Jasi Xmas Cracker date</u> – this is still not definite as there are LC regional meets on all 3 weekends in December which Clubs may want to send their swimmers to. It is not possible to change their bookings, eg to the Memorial meet weekend. It was suggested they should approach the Board to see what their thoughts were on swimmers attending meets out of region when there is a meet on in Canterbury.

Equipment -

Alex is working on the pads at Selwyn this week – 5 of the spare touchpads at Selwyn have been fully fixed (slats) and another will be fixed tomorrow (faulty connector). Two further pads could be fixed with some new slats (we are out of black), and one is now a shell and is most likely beyond economical repair (used for spare parts for the other pads).

I would like to suggest that we ask Debbie to get a quote for some additional black slats to fix the other two – we would need 12 plus a few more spares so I suggest getting a quote for 20.

- The scoreboard works well when plugged in with cables to Quantum and the power.
- We need to get some brackets for the pads at Selwyn we will get a quote for possible ideas so we can get it moving.

<u>New Committee</u> – Fiona has to step down from the Committee as did Dave Prattley. Dave was replaced by Ben Close who has applied to formally join the Committee and been accepted. We had no other applications but the Committee is happy to continue with 5 members. Fiona is happy to help out if needed.

The SCWC Board proposed that a recommendation be sent to the SCWC Events Committee, that Fiona be co-opted back onto the committee for the 2023/2024 season.
